



Scientific name: *Ruellia caroliniensis*

Pronounced: roo-EL-ee-uh kair-oh-lin-ee-EN-sis

Common Name: Carolina Wild Petunia

This small purple bloom is very common in NC and might even be in your backyard if you have a little shade and moist soil. Each bloom only lasts for one day!



Scientific name: *Leucanthemum vulgare*

Pronounced: lew-KAN-theh-mum vul-GAIR-ee

Common Name: Ox-eye Daisy

Daisy-like flowers bloom along the roadside in the summer or other sunny areas. May grow up to 3 ft in height.



Scientific name: *Impatiens capensis*

Pronounced: im-PAY-shuns ka-PEN-sis

Common Name: Jewelweed, Touch-me-not

Grows up to 5 ft with flame orange flowers. Commonly found in wet areas.



Scientific name: *Bignonia capreolata*

Pronounced: big-NO-nee-uh kap-ree-oh-LAH-tuh

Common Name: Trumpet Flower

This flower vines around other sturdy plants like trees. You can find it in a variety of locations and conditions.



Scientific name: *Helianthus decapetalus*

Pronounced: hee-lee-AN-thus de-kap-UH-tal-us

Common Name: Forest Sunflower

This plant is an important food source for pollinators, songbirds, and small mammals. It's also a good host plant for butterfly larvae.
