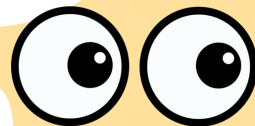

HELPING HANDS

You have the power to take care of our shared space! Use materials with care and put items back where you found them so the next visitor can play too.

STAY TOGETHER

Children of all ages must stay with their grown-ups at all times. Please stay in spaces where kids and adults can always see each other.

WALKING FEET

Indoors, we walk to stay safe.

SNACK AREAS

Food and drinks can be enjoyed in Snack Shack or outdoors. Help us keep the Museum clean by not eating or drinking in other areas.

CLIMB UP, SLIDE DOWN

Slides are safest when everyone moves in one direction—down. Help keep yourself and others safe by not climbing up the slides.

PLANTS ARE ALIVE!

Go out to see what's growing in the garden, play in the exhibits, and sniff the flowers, but please don't pick the produce or pull on the plants.

TOT SPOT = 0-2YRS

Tot Spot is an exhibit just for learners ages 2 and under. This gives littles the freedom to explore and play with their caregivers.
